The following guidelines are for individuals desiring to become a Freedom Appointment ENCOURAGER.

Definition of terms:

Encourager – Individual trained and approved to conduct a Freedom Appointment

Freedom Appointment – An individual is led by an Encourager through Freedom in Christ Steps to Freedom

Guidelines:

- 1. Completed two semesters of FIC Small Group Bible Study
 - No more than two class absences in each semester.
 - Successful completion of the retreat.
 - Must have exhibited enthusiasm and participated in class discussions.
- 2. Completed Encourager Training
 - Class / seminar or FICM online class and practicum.
 - Freedom Appointment training.
- 3. Meet with the CFM Board after expressing interest in becoming an encourager for purpose of:
 - Sharing your heart, calling and vision for ministry.
 - Building relationship with CFM leadership.
 - Using the CFM board as a Resource Center.
 - Understanding authority and spiritual covering of the CFM board.
 - Understanding the need for submission to the CFM board.
 - Using CFM board as a point of contact with FICM
 - **❖** Individuals meeting the guidelines are still subject approval by both CFM Board and Cornerstone Pastoral staff.
