

*The following guidelines are for individuals desiring to become  
a Freedom in Christ (FIC) class facilitator.*

1. Must be a member of Cornerstone Assembly of God in good standing unless otherwise approved by the CFM Board of Directors.

2. Must be in agreement with the Assembly of God 16 Fundamental Truths ([ag.org/Beliefs/Statement-of-Fundamental-Truths](http://ag.org/Beliefs/Statement-of-Fundamental-Truths))

3. Must be in agreement with the Freedom In Christ Ministries (FICM):

- Statement of Faith
- FICM-USA's Mission, Vision, and Core Values

4. Successful completion of **“TWO” FIC class semesters.**

- No more than two class absences per semester.
- Successful completion of the retreat.
- Must have exhibited enthusiasm and participated in class discussions.
- You might be asked to facilitate one or more class sessions **during second semester.**
- You might be asked to help with class administrative needs during second semester.

5. Meet with the CFM Board after expressing interest in becoming a facilitator for purpose of:

- Sharing your heart, calling and vision for ministry.
- Building relationship with CFM leadership.
- Using the CFM board as a Resource Center.
- Understanding authority and spiritual covering of the CFM board.
- Understanding the need for submission to the CFM board.
- Using CFM board as a point of contact with FICM

6. Attend Facilitator Training to discuss topics such as:

- Importance of confidentiality
- Leading classroom discussions
- Time constraints
- Handling difficult situations which may arise.

7. Pair with an approved facilitator to lead a FIC class whether in the church or home.

**❖ Individuals meeting the guidelines are still subject approval by both CFM Board and Cornerstone Pastoral staff.**
